Weekly Fee: \$125/week for the first child and \$100/week per additional child

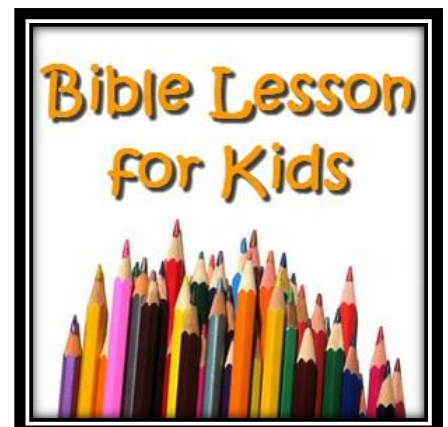
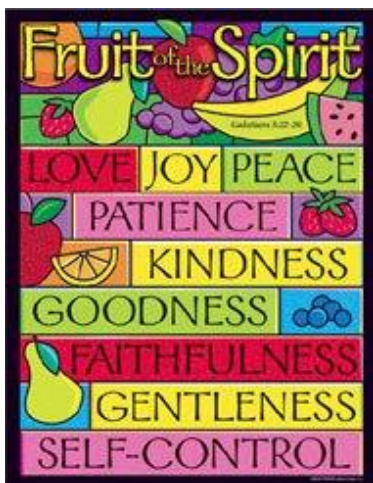
Drop-In fee: \$35 drop in fee per day for the first child and \$25 per day for each additional child (those attending 3 days or less)

Theme Weeks:

Each week will be centered around a theme. Students will create theme related projects/crafts and make theme related healthy snacks. In addition, each week will include a Bible adventure story with short lessons to help deepen their faith.
